Meeting Notes:

- Question about how TrustLands money works when the new school in Remuda opens and the students are split. It is the understanding of Mr. Hales that the money will be based on the number of students attending the school at the time.
- The financial report for last school year was reviewed. Mr. Hales presented the breakdown of how TrustLand money was used last year and answered questions such as leases on chromebooks. The question was asked about how Farr West's chromebook labs will work next year. Will they remain here? How will the leases work? Will some be sent to the new school? The answer to this question is unknown at this time.
- Mr. Hales also presented the current TrustLands Plan for this school year.
- Boundary Maps for Farr West Elementary next school year were discussed.
- Mr. Hales proposed that TrustLand moneys be spent on a phonics program for first grade students which was highly recommended by the reading specialist, Lori Rumsey. The program, Reading Horizons, comes at a cost of roughly \$5,000, and was also recommended by council member Julie Clark who had experience with the program. The council unanimously approved purchasing the program for the 1st grade students at Farr West.
- Next Meeting is scheduled for Jan. 9th where Lori Rumsey, reading specialist, will speak on the Reading Horizons program and reading goals.
